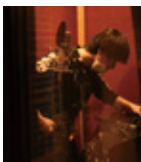

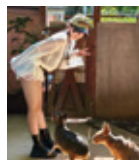

Smart schooling with Copilot!

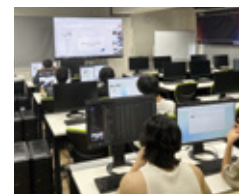

Ms. Liao, a student at TSM Shibuya who took the Logic class, actively asked questions to the teacher.

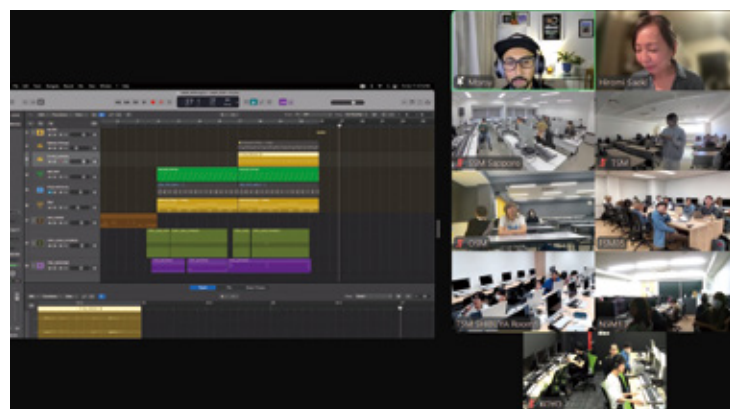
"I was just struggling with how to produce bass lines and drums in my music, and NY Online's explanations helped me understand the areas where I was stuck.

The knowledge of mixing vocals, the new features of Logic, the genres that sell well, and the sound quality required for those genres also helped me a lot in my future song production. I am still a beginner since I started creating music after entering TSM Shibuya, but I was able to better understand what is taught in the regular composition class by having it explained from a different angle in a foreign teaching style. I think the teacher was trying to tell us that composing is simple. I am the type of person who thinks too much, so the teacher taught me in a very simple way, which made it easier to understand.

I asked a lot of questions in the class, but the truth is, I still have more questions I want to ask. I'm looking forward to having the class next time as well."

The presentation included an explanation of how to obtain the necessary art and work visas to work in Japan, as well as a presentation on how to be successful by our graduates and a Q&A session. Mr. Park, who obtained an art visa and is currently working on a serialized manga comic for GauGau Monster (Futabasha), and Mr. Dion, who obtained a work visa and is working at a webtoon production company, were present. Mr. Park said that communication skills are very important for working as a manga artist in Japan. He also talked about the importance of reading manga on a regular basis. Mr. Zheng, a first-grade student majoring in Digital Illustration and Manga who attended the event, said, "Through this information session, I was able to learn not only about debuting but also about finding a job, which was a new discovery for me."
